

RUBY'S PANTRY

There is interest in starting a Ruby's Pantry in our PEM area. This program would also benefit the PEM Food Shelf. If you have any questions, please contact Sue Cain at 507-421-7163 or Trinity Lutheran Church, Elgin at 507-876-2671. There is more information at <u>rubyspantry.org</u>. Ruby's Pantry is a once a month, drive through, pop up pantry and is for ANYONE that eats! There is no income or residency requirement, and Ruby's Pantry is for anyone looking to extend their monthly grocery budget. Each guest donates a \$25 donation and receives an abundance of grocery items. Food items are gathered from manufacturer donations, food overages, surpluses, and bumper crops.

PER CAPITA

We must be mindful of our per capita payments to the Presbytery. Per capita is set at \$40.00 per individual. Our church still owes the Presbytery about \$3,350 in per capita payments. If you haven't paid your per capita for 2024 yet, please do so soon.

COMMUNITY CLOTHESLINE UPDATE:

The missions committee and youth are working to open the Clothesline space. Currently, we are accepting specific items for donations; please keep in mind our customer base is looking for casual and work clothes: women's tops, women's bottoms, men's bottoms, baby boy clothes, tennis shoes (all ages), towels, sheet sets. We also need kitchen items such as pots and pans. Donations can be accepted during church office hours or during clothesline hours. We need volunteers to staff the Clothesline on Thursdays.
